

- Proposal for Cooperative Science Centers shall support NOAA's Strategic Mission
- The EPP supports 1) NOAA Strategic Plan 2) US Ocean Action Plan 3) NOAA Educational Plan 4) DOC/NOAA Succession Planning and Management Program
- Through EPP, NOAA envisions increase in the number of doctoral degree especially amongst minority student through MSI university partnerships

Proposal Writing MUST include these 12 elements

- Standard Form SF424
- Standard Form SF424A
- 3. Budget Justification
- 4. Current and Pending Support (from other federal grants by all PI and co-PIs and also % of time devoted by PIs on those projects as compared to the time that will be devoted to this proposal/project
- 5. Signed Summary Title Page (signed by PI and a Co-PI who can assume responsibility of the program in absence of the PI
- 6. One-page abstract summary
- 7. Project Description complete and divided in annual increment over a five-year period. NOT more than 20 pages – includes figures/visual materials but excludes references, milestones charts, letter of collaboration from unfunded collaborators, letters of endorsement and curriculum vitae not exceeding 2 pages for each PI, Co-PI or Distinguished Scientist.
- 8. Reference Cited
- Milestone Chart: Timeline projection for major tasks covering the duration of the proposed project.
- 10. Evaluation of Program applicant should provide a plan for evaluation of program accomplishments with specific criteria and performed measures. If the project is selected for funding the evaluation plan may be further refined with the Program Manager.
- 11. Federal, State and Local Govt. Activities....should include a list of related fed, state and local govt. activities including other efforts funded through NOAA, that will affect this proposal also describe the relationship
- 12. Electronically submitted page margin must be one inch (2.5 cm) at the T, B, L and R, and typeface standard 12-point size and should be single spaces and have page numbers.

Drafting of the proposal began almost six months prior to the announcement in December 2005.

The Annual/Semi-annual performance report submitted (October 2005) prior to the recompetition served as the **baseline document** in writing the proposal

- Technical Report (CREST Research & Science)
- Education & Outreach
- Budget
- Gathering; compiling; writing and submitting the proposal in the desired format

- Milestone Charts emphasizing the five-year timeline projections for major research projects and tasks
- Performance Metrics for Project evaluations
 - □ Research projects NOAA Science Relevancy and Collaborations
 - Number of students trained and graduated in NOAA Related Sciences
 - □ Peer-reviewed research publications
